### **PERMITTING- A BRIEF SUMMARY OF THE CITY'S GUIDELINES**

When do I need to get a permit? Who do I ask? Where do I go? How long does it take to get a permit? Whenever you are considering work on your home, you should always check to see if a permit is required by the City. In any case, you are always required to submit an Architectural Approval Application to the Civic Association!

Here are some answers about permits:

- Electrical: All electrical work requires a permit and must be completed by a licensed electrical contractor that is registered with the City.
- Plumbing: Permits are NOT required to replace bathroom or kitchen faucets, toilet ballcocks or water control valves, or garbage disposals. Permits ARE required for all other plumbing work like replacing sinks.
- Mechanical: Permits are NOT required for the installation or replacement of thermostats and grills that are part of the HVAC system. Permits ARE required for all other mechanical work.

In short, when in doubt, call or email and get the permit first!

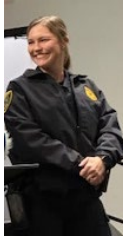


## GRAFITTI AND GANGS

There is a direct relationship between graffiti and gang activity in any Houston neighborhood. It's a part of the broken windows theory that lesser crimes must be addressed to prevent bigger crimes from happening. We have a contact with the City's Gang Prevention and Intervention Department that allows us to send them pictures of graffiti we see in and around Binglewood. ## HPD'S ENVIRONMENTAL INVESTIGATION UNIT

Did you know HPD has a separate environmental investigation unit dedicated to preventing illegal dumping, air and water pollution and radioactive waste?

With only 12 employees, 8 of which are assigned to investigate, the Environmental Unit needs our help. Tasked with investigating all crimes with an environmental nexus in the City of Houston, the majority of cases are follow-ups to reports from the community. Investigators are on call to respond to danger and major areas of dumping. The most important and tangible way to reduce the impact of illegal dumping in our neighborhoods is to clean it up as quickly as possible while implementing preventive solutions to reduce the chances of recurrence. The presence of dumping often leads to more dumping and chronic dumping in neighborhoods is tied directly to negative social outcomes. Like the "broken windows" theory, taking care of smaller problems quickly as they occur helps prevent the bigger and more damaging problems from happening.

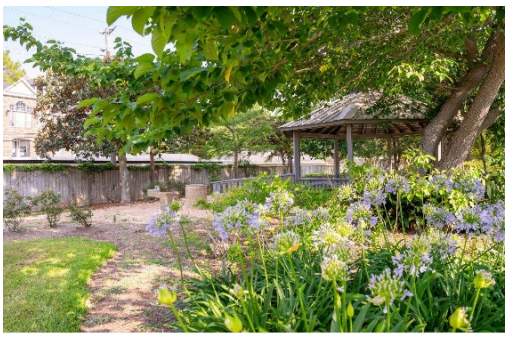

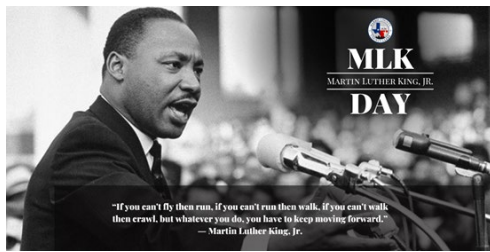

**STEAR IN CASE OF EMERGENCIES** If you or your neighbors need additional assistance during emergency events, they can sign up for the State of Texas Emergency Assistance Registry (STEAR). This registry provides first responders and local emergency planners with additional information on the needs of the people in our community. This service is especially useful for people with disabilities, people with limited mobility, communication barriers, those who need transportation assistance, and who may require additional medical assistance during an emergency event. 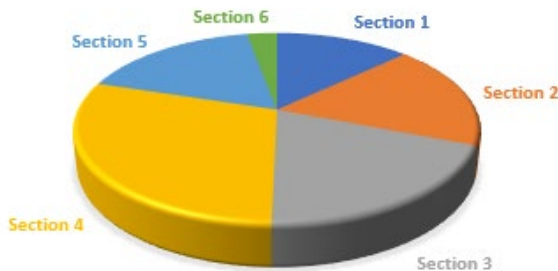

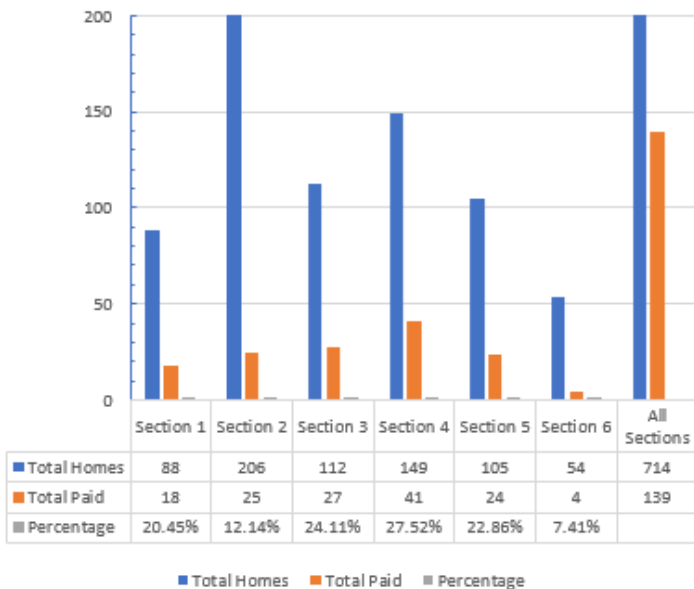
Below are a pie chart of all dues received during 2024 by section and a bar graph showing total homes in each section vs. total contributors.

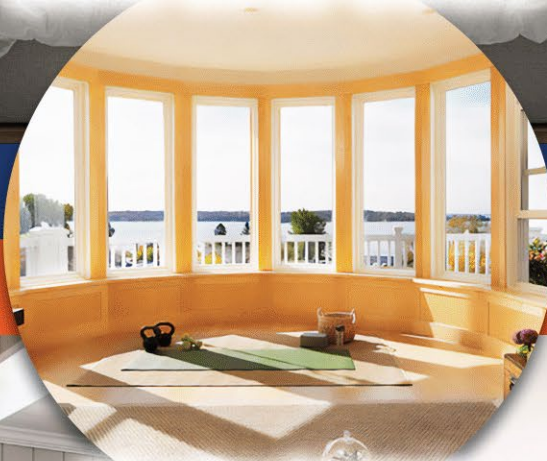

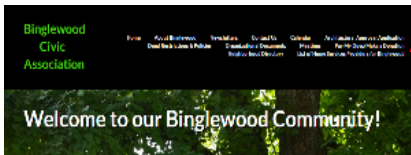
