Feature	Professional Security Patrol	Neighborhood Cameras
How it Works:	In-person security guards driving marked patrol vehicles throughout Section IV, including the James Lee Park.	Automated high-resolution cameras placed at strategic Section IV locations by a contracted security services provider.
Primary Goal:	Active Prevention: Stops crime before or while it happens through a visible, physical presence.	Evidence for Investigations: Provides high-quality visual evidence to help HPD catch suspects during or after a crime occurs.
Coverage Area:	Mobile & Flexible: The security guard drives all Section IV streets and physically checks James Lee Park.	Fixed Points: Continuously monitors specific locations 24 hours a day.
Time Limits:	Part-Time: Operates for a set number of hours a few days per week on a flexible, varying weekly schedule so routine is unpredictable.	Full-Time: Runs 24 / 7 / 365 without stopping, completely independent of human shifts.
Appearance:	Marked black SUVs with security logos. Uniformed personnel. Signs would be posted.	Discreet pole-mounted cameras powered by solar panels.
Impact to Section IV:	Provides an immediate, visible uniformed presence that discourages porch pirates, property crimes, vagrancy, speeding, vandalism, misuse of the park, and more serious crimes.	Creates a digital record that detects and monitors crimes as they occur and provides a visual deterrent.
